

Pee Wee (B)

Field Dimensions: Bases 70 Feet, Mound at 48 Feet from the plate and the mound is optional

Game Length: Min. 3 ½, Max. 6 innings, after 90 minutes from game start is the last inning.

Innings: 5 run maximum per inning, except the last inning which is always an open inning (time or 6th). If a player hits a home run outside the park all runs count.

Mercy Rule: 10 point difference and 3 ½ innings played.

Stealing: Is allowed, however, no runner may leave the base before the ball crosses the plate or is hit (NO LEADING). If a runner breaks this rule he is out and the ball is dead.

- From 3rd you can ONLY run home on a hit ball or a forced play.

- If a team has a 5 run lead then stealing is NOT allowed. Any player who steals is returned to his base.

of Players: 7 players minimum

Pitches: Regular balls, strikes, and walks apply

Bunts: NOT allowed, considered a strike if tried.

Dropped 3rd Strike: The batter is out but the ball is live. Runners can steal 2nd or 3rd.

Balks: No Balks- Runners return to base

Play Ends: - When the pitcher has the ball, he is on the mound and the catcher is ready. At that point runners return to the last base occupied.

Pitching: A catcher may pitch, but if a player has pitched, they can NOT catch again that day.

-Pitchers cannot return to pitching once they leave that position.

- A player cannot pitch three (3) consecutive days

INTENTIONAL BASE ON BALLS: The coach tells the plate umpire and a walk is automatically called

NUMBER OF INNINGS for Pitchers (regular season)

*****Las St Louis amendment *****

Pitcher can pitch a maximum of 3 innings in a game

- Max. 6 innings in a DAY

- After 2 innings in a day- no rest required

-After 3 + innings in a game or day - 2 complete days of rest (2 sleeps)

- After 6 innings in a day- 3 complete days of rest (3 sleeps)

- A single pitch in an inning is considered an inning pitched

Visit to the mound: If the coach visits to the mound twice in 1 inning for the same pitcher, the pitcher must be replaced

Call – Ups: From: Mosquito A (Can NOT pitch) or Mosquito B. Maximum 5 call ups per game. Call ups must be identified on the line up sheets.

Fair Play:

- All players are listed on the batting line up, and each takes their at bat in turn.
- A late arriving player is added to the BOTTOM of the batting list
- If a player leaves during the game he is removed from the line up – No automatic out.
- If a player cannot complete his at bat, the next player on the list takes his place with his pitch count. The replaced player can be reinserted in the game.
- - If a runner cannot continue, he is replaced by the last out. The replaced player can be reinserted in the game.
- -A player must **start** in the field at least one of every two games he attends.
- -An equitable usage of the players must be made. No player can sit 2 innings in a row.
- Players come in and out of positions at will, pitchers follow above pitching rules.
